2. Notwithstanding the Accepted Recognition Delta(s) the conduct of regulatory assurance, as detailed in the MARQ Responses to Sub-Sections A, C and D, is considered to be suitable as regards to the LAA ČR artefacts on common Air Systems, listed in the Implementation Arrangement to be considered or used by UA MAA.
3. LAA ČR undertakes to inform UA MAA in all reasonable haste of any significant changes to their Authority. This is to include, but is not limited to, significant changes to their published airworthiness regulations.
4. Artefacts relevant to the activities may be delivered through the governance of dedicated agreements (Implementing Arrangement) and may be accepted in accordance with the conditions specified in the UA MAA national regulations.
5. The Recognition Certificate remains valid indefinitely as long as point 3 is complied with. Recognition Partners will review the Implementing Arrangement (IA) every 4 years, or otherwise agreed upon, from the date of coming into effect of the IA.
6. The essential principle that Recognition is a national responsibility is maintained, hence sovereign regulatory responsibility is not abdicated by issuance of this Recognition Certificate.
7. The UA MAA is duly authorised to make the agreements given above.
